



## £100,000 RED & ORANGE GAME PROCEDURES

This Game is subject to the Rules for Scratchcard Lottery Games ("the Rules") which appear in a separate document available for inspection at Retailers, and to these Procedures. The meaning of any word or term in these Procedures shall be as defined in the Rules unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

**Game Name:** "£100,000 Red & Orange"

**Game Number:** "Game 415"

**Retail Sales Price:** £1 per Ticket

There is a 1 in 4.90 overall chance of winning a prize on each Ticket. There are 38,150,160 Tickets in the initial print run of this Game.

### Play Style and Determining Winners for £100,000 Red & Orange

The owner of a Ticket having three identical Play Symbols with the corresponding Play Captions under the coating in the Play Area shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to a prize equal to the amount of one of those three identical Play Symbols.

Nine Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions which verify the Play Symbols will appear in the Play Area. Only one Play Caption appears under each Play Symbol. Only the Play Symbols and Play Captions can be used to play the Game.

### Prize Value in The Game

The total value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game represents 59.96% of the total face value of Tickets. The overall value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game is £22,872,974.

The number of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game relates to the number of Tickets recorded on the Company's central computer and formally notified to the National Lottery Commission prior to the sale of any Tickets. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account subsequent sale or loss of Tickets, subsequent withdrawal of Tickets where those Tickets are withdrawn by the Company without knowledge of whether they are prize bearing Tickets or additional print run(s) of Tickets for the Game. The Company may, with the consent of the National Lottery Commission, print further Tickets for this Game. In the event that any further print run of Tickets for this Game is made then, in respect of the Tickets comprising that further print run, the odds of winning a prize at each prize level will be at least as good as the initial print run, and details of the prize structure for that further print run will be available from the National Lottery Line.

In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between these Procedures and any other information issued by the Company in respect of this Game, these Procedures will prevail.
