

Bingo Blue Game Procedures

This Game is subject to the Rules for Scratchcard Lottery Games ("the Rules") which appear in a separate document available for inspection at Retailers, and to these Procedures. The meaning of any word or term in these Procedures shall be as defined in the Rules unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Game Name: **"Bingo Blue"**
 Game Number: **"Game 0498"**
 Retail Sales Price: **£3 per Ticket**

There is a 1 in 3.92 overall chance of winning a prize on each Ticket. There are 19,333,260 Tickets in the initial print run of this Game.

Play Style and Determining Winners for Bingo Blue

The Scratchcard comprises five sections, identified as the CALLER'S CARD, CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and CARD 4. Scratching off the coating on the CALLER'S CARD will reveal 20 Bingo Numbers. Each CARD consists of a blue prize table (a "Prize Table") and 25 squares; 24 of which have Play Symbols consisting of numbers printed in them, and the middle square containing a 'FREE' Play Symbol (a "Free Square").

The Game is played by scratching off all of the coating on the CALLER'S CARD to reveal the Bingo Numbers then matching the Bingo Numbers to the numbers shown on CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and CARD 4. In order to confirm and verify that a number in one of the 4 CARDS matches a Bingo Number players should scratch off that number(s) on a CARD to mark the identical number(s) (a "Matching Number").

To win a prize listed in the Prize Table on a CARD, a Player must have a Ticket containing Matching Numbers in one of the following patterns on that CARD (a "Winning Pattern"):



ROWS



Example

There must be 5 Matching Numbers in a horizontal line on CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and/or CARD 4 or

There must be 4 Matching Numbers and a Free Square in a horizontal line on CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and/or CARD 4

[NB – It is not possible to have 2 rows on one card.]

COLUMNS



Example

There must be 5 Matching Numbers in a vertical line on CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and/or CARD 4 or

There must be 4 Matching Numbers and a Free Square in a vertical line on CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and/or CARD 4

[NB – It is not possible to have 2 columns on one card.]

DIAGONAL



Examples



There must be 4 Matching Numbers and a Free Square in a diagonal line on CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and/or CARD 4

CORNERS



Example

4 CORNERS – There must be a Matching Number in each of the 4 corners of CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and/or CARD 4

A Player who has a Ticket with a Winning Pattern on any CARD shall be entitled, subject to the Rules, to the corresponding prize for the Winning Pattern described in the Prize Table for that CARD.

A Player can win up to 4 times on a Ticket but only once on any CARD.

20 Play Symbols will appear under the coating of the CALLER'S CARD. 24 Play Symbols will appear on each of CARD 1, CARD 2, CARD 3 and CARD 4. Only the Play Symbols can be used to play the Game.

Play symbols from one CARD cannot be combined with Play Symbols in any other CARD to win.

A Prize Table on one CARD cannot be combined with a Prize Table on any other CARD to determine a prize to which a Player may be entitled.

The total value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game represents 65.97% of the total face value of Tickets. The overall value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game is £38,264,043.

The number of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game relates to the number of Tickets recorded on the Company's central computer and formally notified to the National Lottery Commission prior to the sale of any Tickets. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account subsequent sale or loss of Tickets or subsequent withdrawal of Tickets where those Tickets are withdrawn by the Company without knowledge of whether they are prize bearing Tickets. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between these Procedures and any other information issued by the Company in respect of this Game, these Procedures will prevail.
