

Lucky Devil Game Procedures

This Game is subject to the Rules for Scratchcard Lottery Games ("the Rules") which appear in a separate document available for inspection at Retailers, and to these Procedures. The meaning of any word or term in these Procedures shall be as defined in the Rules unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

There is a 1 in 4.95 overall chance of winning a prize on each Ticket. There are 21,913,600 Tickets in the initial print run of this Game.

Play Style and Determining Winners for Lucky Devil

The Play Area, comprises underneath the coating, four Play Symbols and corresponding Play Captions in the section of the Ticket bearing the words "YOUR SYMBOLS" (the "YOUR SYMBOLS Section") and one Play Symbol and corresponding Play Caption in the section of the Ticket bearing the words "LUCKY SYMBOL" (the "LUCKY SYMBOL Section").

The owner of a Ticket which, in the LUCKY SYMBOL Section, has a Play Symbol with corresponding Play Caption which matches a Play Symbol with corresponding Play Caption in the YOUR SYMBOLS Section shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to a prize amount equal to the Prize Symbol shown immediately below that Play Symbol in the YOUR SYMBOLS Section.

Players can win up to 4 times on a Ticket.

One Play Symbol with corresponding Play Caption which verifies that Play Symbol will appear under the coating of the LUCKY SYMBOL Section. Four Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions which verify those Play Symbols will appear in the YOUR SYMBOLS Section. Only one Play Caption appears under each Play Symbol. Only the Play Symbols and Play Captions can be used to play the Game.

One Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption which verifies that Prize Symbol will appear under each of the four Play Symbols and Play Captions in the YOUR SYMBOLS Section. Only one Prize Caption appears under each Prize Symbol. Only the Prize Symbol and corresponding Prize Caption can be used to determine the amount of a Prize to which the Player may be entitled in respect of the Play Symbol immediately above that Prize Symbol.

A Play Symbol or Prize Symbol under one motif cannot be combined with a Play Symbol or Prize Symbol under another motif to win.

Prize Value in The Game

The total value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game represents 59.09% of the total face value of Tickets. The overall value of prizes in the initial print run of tickets for the Game is £12,948,330.

The number of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game relates to the number of Tickets recorded on the Company's central computer and formally notified to the National Lottery Commission prior to the sale of any Tickets. These Game Procedures provide accurate information for the initial print run at the point of launch. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account subsequent sale or loss of Tickets, subsequent withdrawal of Tickets where those Tickets are withdrawn by the Company without knowledge of whether they are prize bearing Tickets, or additional print run(s) of Tickets for the Game. The Company may print further Tickets for this Game. In the event that any further print run of Tickets for this Game is made, then, in respect of the Tickets comprising that further print run, the overall odds of winning a prize at each prize tier level will be, allowing for the tolerance levels as specified in the table above, the same as in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game.

In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between these Procedures and any other information issued by the Company in respect of this Game, these Procedures will prevail.
