

Lucky Streak Game Procedures

This Game is subject to the Rules for Scratchcard Lottery Games ("the Rules") which appear in a separate document available for inspection at Retailers, and to these Procedures. The meaning of any word or term in these Procedures shall be as defined in the Rules unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Game Name: "Lucky Streak"
 Game Number: "Game 0496"
 Retail Sales Price: £2 per Ticket

There is a 1 in 4.48 overall chance of winning a prize on each Ticket. There are 10,427,680 Tickets in the initial print run of this Game.

Play Style and Determining Winners for Lucky Streak

There are two Play Areas on a Ticket, identified as GAME 1 and GAME 2.

A player can win up to eight times on a ticket.



GAME 1

There are four sections in the Play Area of the Game each called a 'HAND'. These are shown on the Ticket face as HAND 1, HAND 2, HAND 3 and HAND 4; each HAND comprises of one or motifs in the section of the ticket below the words 'YOUR CARD' (the "YOUR CARDS Section") and one of or motifs in the section of the ticket below the words 'THEIR CARD' (the "THEIR CARD'S Section").

The owner of a Ticket which under the coating of the YOUR CARDS Section has a Play Symbol with corresponding Play Caption higher than the Play Symbol with corresponding Play Caption under the coating of the THEIR CARD Section shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to the amount of the Prize Symbol shown under the coating of the section of that HAND marked 'PRIZE'. An Ace beats a King, a King beats a Queen, a Queen beats a Jack and a Jack beats a 10.

Two Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions, which verify those Play Symbols, will appear under the coating of each HAND. Only one Play Caption appears under each Play Symbol.

One Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption will appear in each HAND. Only the Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption set out in a HAND can be used to determine the amount of the Prize to which the Player may be entitled in respect of the relevant HAND.

GAME 2

There are four sections in the Play Area of the Game each called a 'ROLL'. These are shown on the Ticket face as ROLL 1, ROLL 2, ROLL 3 and ROLL 4; under the coating each ROLL comprises on a horizontal line two Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions and an adjoining Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption. The owner of a Ticket which has under the coating in one ROLL two identical Play Symbols with the corresponding Play Captions shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to a prize equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol in that ROLL.

Two Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions, which verify the Play Symbols, will appear under the coating of each ROLL. Only one Play Caption appears under each Play Symbol. Play Symbols in one ROLL cannot be combined with Play Symbols in another ROLL or ROLLS to win.

One Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption which verifies the Prize Symbol will appear under the coating of each ROLL. Only one Prize Caption appears under each Prize Symbol. Only the Prize Symbol and corresponding Prize Caption in a ROLL can be used to determine the amount of the prize to which the Player may be entitled in respect of that ROLL.

Prize Value in The Game

The total value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game represents 64.03% of the total face value of Tickets. The overall value of prizes in the initial print run of tickets for the Game is £13,353,418.

The number of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game relates to the number of Tickets recorded on the Company's central computer and formally notified to the National Lottery Commission prior to the sale of any Tickets. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account subsequent sale or loss of Tickets, subsequent withdrawal of Tickets where those Tickets are withdrawn by the Company without knowledge of whether they are prize bearing Tickets, or additional print run(s) of Tickets for the Game. The Company may print further Tickets for this Game. In the event that any further print run of Tickets for this Game is made, then, in respect of the Tickets comprising that further print run, the overall odds of winning a prize at each prize tier level will be, allowing for the tolerance levels as specified in the table above, the same as in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between these Procedures and any other information issued by the Company in respect of this Game, these Procedures will prevail.
