

# Super 7s Game Procedures

This Game is subject to the Rules for Scratchcard Lottery Games ("the Rules") which appear in a separate document available for inspection at Retailers, and to these Procedures. The meaning of any word or term in these Procedures shall be as defined in the Rules unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Game Name: "SUPER 7s"  
 Game Number: "Game 0499"  
 Retail Sales Price: £2 per Ticket

There is a 1 in 4.43 overall chance of winning a prize on each Ticket.  
 There are 12,919,600 Tickets in the initial print run of this Game.

## Play Style and Determining Winners for SUPER 7s

There are two Play Areas on a Ticket, identified as Game 1 and Game 2.  
 A player can win up to eight times on a ticket.



## Game 1

There are four sections in the Game 1 Play Area, each called a 'ROW'. These are shown on the Ticket face as ROW 1, ROW 2, ROW 3 and ROW 4. Each ROW comprises on a horizontal line two '0' motifs, a '+' motif and the word 'PRIZE' (Prize Box).

The owner of a Ticket which under the coating in a ROW has two numeric Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions which when added together total exactly seven shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to a prize equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol under the coating of the Prize Box for that ROW.

### Play Symbols and Play Captions for Game 1

Two Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions, which verify the Play Symbols, will appear under the coating of each ROW. Only one Play Caption appears under each Play Symbol.

One Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption will appear in each Prize Box. Only the Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption set out in a Prize Box can be used to determine the amount of the prize to which the Player may be entitled in respect of the relevant ROW in Game 1.

## Game 2

There are four sections in the Game 2 Play Area, each called a 'ROW'. These are shown on the Ticket face as ROW 1, ROW 2, ROW 3 and ROW 4. Each ROW comprises on a horizontal line a '+' motif and a section headed PRIZE under which appears a Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption (the "Prize Box"). The owner of a Ticket which has under the coating bearing the '+' motif a '7' Play Symbol with corresponding Play Caption shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to a prize equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol under the coating of the Prize Box for that ROW.

#### Prize Value in The Game

The total value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game represents 63.41% of the total face value of Tickets. The overall value of prizes in the initial print run of tickets for the Game is £16,384,472.

The number of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game relates to the number of Tickets recorded on the Company's central computer and formally notified to the National Lottery Commission prior to the sale of any Tickets. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account subsequent sale or loss of Tickets, subsequent withdrawal of Tickets where those Tickets are withdrawn by the Company without knowledge of whether they are prize bearing Tickets, or additional print run(s) of Tickets for the Game. The Company may print further Tickets for this Game. In the event that any further print run of Tickets for this Game is made, then, in respect of the Tickets comprising that further print run, the overall odds of winning a prize at each prize tier level will be, allowing for the tolerance levels as specified in the table above, the same as in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game.

In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between these Procedures and any other information issued by the Company in respect of this Game, these Procedures will prevail.
