

# Top Cat Cash Game Procedures

This Game is subject to the Rules for Scratchcard Lottery Games ("the Rules") which appear in a separate document available for inspection at Retailers, and to these Procedures. The meaning of any word or term in these Procedures shall be as defined in the Rules unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

There is a 1 in 4.81 overall chance of winning a prize on each Ticket. There are 25,825,280 Tickets in the initial print run of this Game.



## Play Style and Determining Winners for Top Cat Cash

The owner of a Ticket having three identical Play Symbols with the corresponding Play Captions under the coating in the Play Area shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to a prize equal to the amount of one of those three identical Play Symbols.

The owner of a Ticket having a  Play Symbol with corresponding Play Caption under the coating in the Play Area shall, subject to the Rules, be automatically entitled to a prize of £5.

## Prize Value in The Game

The Company may print further Tickets for this Game. In the event that any further print run of Tickets for this Game is made, then, in respect of the Tickets comprising that further print run, the overall odds of winning a prize at each prize tier level will be, allowing for the tolerance levels as specified in the table above, the same as in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game. In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between these Procedures and any other information issued by the Company in respect of this Game, these Procedures will prevail.
