

# Try Your Luck 2011 Game Procedures

This Game is subject to the Rules for Scratchcard Lottery Games ("the Rules") which appear in a separate document available for inspection at Retailers, and to these Procedures. The meaning of any word or term in these Procedures shall be as defined in the Rules unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

## Play Style and Determining Winners for TRY YOUR LUCK 2011

There are three sections in the Play Area of the Game each called a 'ROW'. These are shown on the Ticket face as ROW 1, ROW 2 and ROW 3; each comprises on a horizontal line, two Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions and an adjoining section marked PRIZE (the "Prize Box"). The owner of a Ticket which has under the coating in one ROW two identical Play Symbols with the corresponding Play Captions shall, subject to the Rules, be entitled to a prize equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol in the Prize Box for that ROW.

Players can win up to 3 times on a Ticket.

Two Play Symbols with corresponding Play Captions, which verify the Play Symbols, will appear under the coating of each ROW. Only one Play Caption appears under each Play Symbol. Play Symbols in one ROW cannot be combined with Play Symbols in another ROW or ROWS to win.

One Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption which verifies the Prize Symbol will appear under the coating of each Prize Box. Only the Prize Symbol with corresponding Prize Caption set out under the coating of a Prize Box can be used to determine the amount of the prize to which the Player may be entitled in respect of the relevant ROW.

### Prize Value in The Game

The total value of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game represents 58.50% of the total face value of Tickets. The overall value of prizes in the initial print run of tickets for the Game is £13,214,420.

The number of prizes in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game relates to the number of Tickets recorded on the Company's central computer and formally notified to the National Lottery Commission prior to the sale of any Tickets. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account subsequent sale or loss of Tickets, subsequent withdrawal of Tickets where those Tickets are withdrawn by the Company without knowledge of whether they are prize bearing Tickets, or additional print run(s) of Tickets for the Game. The Company may print further Tickets for this Game. In the event that any further print run of Tickets for this Game is made, then, in respect of the Tickets comprising that further print run, the overall odds of winning a prize at each prize tier level will be, allowing for the tolerance levels as specified in the table above, the same as in the initial print run of Tickets for the Game.

In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between these Procedures and any other information issued by the Company in respect of this Game, these Procedures will prevail.
