

# Cars & Cash Game Procedures

## Introduction

These are the Game Procedures for CARS & CASH (the "Game"). When the Game is played, the Rules for Scratchcard Games (the "Rules"), the Game Specific Rules and these Procedures apply. The Rules and Game Specific Rules can be viewed at Retailers and on the National Lottery website at [national-lottery.co.uk](http://national-lottery.co.uk).

Any word or term in these Procedures that has a specific meaning will have the meaning given to it in these Procedures or the Rules (unless the context clearly indicates otherwise).

## Game details

Game Name: "CARS & CASH"

Game Number: "Game 1248"

Retail Sales Price: **£2 per Scratchcard**

There is a 1 in 3.72 overall chance of winning a Prize on each Scratchcard in this Game. There are 9,913,200 Scratchcards in the initial print run of this Game.

## How to play and win

The Play Area has two GAMES labelled as GAME 1 and GAME 2.

Players can win up to 7 times on a Scratchcard.

## GAME 1

The GAME 1 Play Area has four rows labelled as 'ROW 1', 'ROW 2', 'ROW 3' and 'ROW 4'. Each ROW has the ROW number,

one  motif under the column headed 'YOUR NUMBER', one  motif under the column headed 'THEIR NUMBER' and the word 'PRIZE' (the "Prize Box"). You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if, in a ROW you reveal a Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption under the coating of the heading 'YOUR NUMBER' which is greater than the Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption under the coating of the heading 'THEIR NUMBER'. The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol with its matching Prize Caption under the coating of the Prize Box for that ROW.

Only the GAME 1 Prize Symbol and its matching Prize Caption under the coating of a Prize Box in a ROW can be used to confirm the amount of a Prize You may be entitled to, if any, in respect of a ROW in GAME 1.

### GAME 2

The GAME 2 Play Area has three  motifs and the word 'PRIZE' (the "Prize Box") immediately below each  motif in the section headed 'YOUR SYMBOLS' (the "Your Symbols Section") and one  motif, in the section headed 'WINNING SYMBOL' (the "Winning Symbol Section").

You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if You reveal a Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption under the coating in the Winning Symbol Section that matches a Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption under the coating in the Your Symbols Section. The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol shown with its matching Prize Caption under the coating of the Prize Box immediately below the matching Play Symbol in the Your Symbols Section.

Three Play Symbols with their matching Play Captions will appear under the coating in the Your Symbols Section in GAME 2. Only the GAME 2 Play Symbols and Play Captions can be used to play GAME 2.

One Prize Symbol with its matching Prize Caption will appear immediately below the Play Symbol and its matching Play Caption, under the coating of each Prize Box in the Your Symbols Section. Only one Prize Caption appears under each Prize Symbol. Only the Prize Symbol and its matching Prize Caption under the coating of a Prize Box in the Your Symbols Section can be used to confirm the amount of a Prize You may be entitled to, if any, in respect of GAME 2.



## BOTH GAMES

If You win in a GAME and the Prize is **CAR**, You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize. The Prize will be a brand new BMW X2 Model, and a cash prize of £30,000. Game Specific Rules apply to this Prize, which can be found below.

### Prize Value in The Game

The total value of Prizes in the print run of Scratchcards for the Game represents 66.76% of the total face value of Scratchcards. The overall value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game is £13,236,045.90.

The number of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game relates to the number of Scratchcards recorded on Camelot's Computer System and formally notified to the Gambling Commission before any Scratchcards are sold. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account any future sale or loss of Scratchcards, or future withdrawal of Scratchcards (where those Scratchcards are withdrawn by Camelot without knowledge of whether they are Prize bearing Scratchcards).

### General

In the event of any conflict between these Procedures and any other information issued by Camelot in relation to this Game, these Procedures will take priority (except if any Game Specific Rules apply to this Game in which case they will take priority over these Procedures).

## **GAME SPECIFIC RULES RELATING TO 1248 CARS & CASH PRIZES**

When You play the National Lottery Scratchcard Game "CARS & CASH" (Game No. 1248) (the "Game") these Game Specific Rules (the "Rules"), the Game Procedures (the "Procedures") and the National Lottery Rules for Scratchcard Games ("the Scratchcard Rules") apply. These Rules deal with the payment and award of the Car Prizes defined in these Rules. For information about the Game (including how to play and win) see the Procedures.

If there is any conflict between the documents mentioned above, these Rules and the Procedures will take priority, followed by the Scratchcard Rules (unless the Scratchcard Rules say otherwise).

You can view the Scratchcard Rules and Procedures, together with any Game Specific Rules, on the National Lottery website at [national-lottery.co.uk/scratchcards](http://national-lottery.co.uk/scratchcards). The Scratchcard Rules are also available to view at Retailers. You can also get copies of all documents by calling the National Lottery Line on 0333 234 50 50 (see the Telephone Enquiries section for call charges), or by writing to The National Lottery, PO Box 251, Watford, WD18 9BR.

All words and phrases in these Rules that begin with a capital letter and have a specific meaning are explained in Rule 8 below or in the Scratchcard Rules (unless the context clearly indicates otherwise).

### **1. Claiming Car Prizes**

- 1.1 Car Prizes must be claimed in person before the end of the Claim Period (as set out in the Scratchcard Rules). You must phone the National Lottery Line during its normal opening hours\* and during the Claim Period to arrange an appointment with a Camelot representative(s). Your entitlement to the Car Prize will be lost (and the Car Prize won't be awarded) if the Car Prize is not claimed within the Claim Period. Car Prize claims will be validated at Your home or other agreed location, or at a Regional Centre.  
  
\*At the time of writing these Rules, the Contact Centre's opening hours are 8.00am to 8.00pm Monday to Saturday and 9am – 5pm Sundays. Reduced opening hours may apply over the Christmas and New Year period. See the National Lottery website for current opening hours.
- 1.2 During Your call with the National Lottery Line, You will be asked for certain information, including Your name, address, telephone number(s) and date of birth ("Personal Information").
- 1.3 During Your appointment with the Camelot representative(s), once Camelot has successfully validated Your claim, and subject to these Rules, You will be asked to complete a Prize Claim Form (provided by Camelot), or any other form Camelot requires You to complete, and present it along with the winning Scratchcard, proof of entitlement to claim and confirmation of the Personal Information mentioned in Rule 1.2 above and Rule 1.5(a) below.
- 1.4 Once Camelot has successfully validated Your claim, and subject to these Rules, Camelot will provide You with a letter confirming You are entitled to a Car Prize. The letter will set out the information and documents Camelot requires You to send to Camelot, including but not limited to the documents mentioned in Rule 1.5(a) below. This documentation may be sent digitally, or provided as part of the validation process, depending on Covid restrictions.
- 1.5 You:
  - a. will need to send Camelot Your winning ticket, together with a completed Contact Details form, and where one has been appointed in line with Rule 2.3, a Nominee form. Both these forms will include an authorisation for a representative from the Dealer to complete and sign a certificate of vehicle registration on behalf of You (or, at Your request, Your Nominee);
  - b. or Your Nominee, will be required to provide a copy of Your (or their) Driving Licence and all relevant car insurance documents and any other documents Camelot and/or the Dealer asks You to provide;
  - c. will lose Your right to receive a Car as part of a Car Prize if You fail to arrange delivery of the Car within ten weeks of Your claim being validated. The only exception to this will be in circumstances where You or Your Nominee has been prevented from arranging delivery of the Car for reasons attributable to Camelot or the Car Manufacturer.
- 1.6 Once Your claim has been successfully validated in line with the requirements of the Scratchcard Rules, the Procedures and these Rules, the cash prize element of the Car Prize (being £30,000) will be paid to You by Camelot, unless Rule 1.7 or Rule 6 below applies. Delivery of the Car will be in line with Rule 2.
- 1.7 It is possible that a third party will come forward to Camelot during the Prize claim period, claiming that they are the legal representative of a deceased Player and are therefore entitled to receive the Car Prize instead of or for that deceased Player (for example as the executor of a deceased Player's estate). In such cases, Camelot will suspend award of the Car Prize until it can establish who is properly entitled to receive the Car Prize.
- 1.8 Camelot will not be liable to pay interest to You, or any third party mentioned in Rule 1.7 above, if the cash element of the Car Prize is delayed.

## 2. Specification and Delivery of the Car

- 2.1 You will be entitled to choose the exterior colour of the Car, the interior cloth upholstery colour, and the colour of the wheels from a specified list which will be provided by Camelot.
- 2.2 If You wish to improve the specification of the Car, this will be at an additional cost to You and subject to the Dealer's rules and availability.
- 2.3 In exceptional circumstances, Camelot may allow You to appoint a Nominee. Exceptional circumstances include, but are not limited to, Your inability to drive the Car as a result of not having a Driving Licence, or being physically unable to. You must make any such appointment in writing by completing the Nominee form provided by Camelot, and by the deadline given by Camelot. A Nominee must have a Driving Licence enabling him to drive the Car and be at least 18 years old. The Nominee will be asked to produce proof of age acceptable to Camelot, and to complete any documents which Camelot and/or Dealer reasonably require.
- 2.4 You or Your Nominee will be responsible for making the Car delivery and/or collection arrangements with the Dealer.
- 2.5 Before the Car can be delivered to or collected by You or Your Nominee, You or Your Nominee will need to:
  - a. produce any identification requested by the Dealer, and sign any documents the Dealer reasonably requires You to sign; and
  - b. provide the Dealer with an original motor insurance certificate in relation to the Car, which has been issued by an authorised motor vehicle insurance company and is valid in the United Kingdom and Isle of Man. The insurance must be in the name of (or must name) the person collecting the Car, being You or Your Nominee, and insure that person either on a fully comprehensive or third party basis. The insurance cover must start no later than the seventh day after the Car is registered, and must be valid for at least 28 days from this date.

## 3. Road Tax

Subject to Rule 2.5(b) above, each Car will have 12 months' road tax starting from the first day of the month in which that Car was registered.

## 4. Exclusions of Liability, etc.

- 4.1 Camelot accepts no liability of whatever nature in relation to a Car including, but not limited to, the Car's condition, whether mechanical or otherwise, its reliability or servicing.
- 4.2 In addition, Camelot accepts no liability whatsoever in respect of any breach or alleged breach by the Car Manufacturer or the Dealer (or any other person who provides a guarantee or warranty in relation to the Car Prize) or for any claim, dispute or other matter which arises from, under or in relation to any insurance related to a Car.
- 4.3 You acknowledge that the Car Manufacturer is entitled to and may change the specification of the Car without first informing You. You also acknowledge that the Dealer reserves the right to substitute the Car with another car of similar specification.

## 5. Publicity

- 5.1 Camelot will try its best to ensure that any information about You or Your Nominee that Camelot is required to disclose under these Rules to a third party (for example to arrange collection of the Car from a Dealer), will be treated by that third party as confidential. However, Camelot cannot guarantee that the third party will treat the information as confidential, and is not responsible or liable if this information is released by that third party to others.
- 5.2 Subject to Rule 5.1, You accept, by taking part in the Game, that should You win a Car in the Game, the nature of that prize is such that Your identity as a Car Prize winner may become suspected by or known to third parties. You also confirm you have made any Nominee You appoint aware of this. Camelot can accept no responsibility or liability of whatever nature if this occurs.

## 6. Car Or Cash Alternatives

- 6.1 You cannot request a different car to the Car. However, if You only have an Automatic Driving Licence, You can upgrade the Car for an automatic transmission gearbox at Your own cost.
- 6.2 The Dealer reserves the right in its absolute discretion to substitute for any Car, in the Dealer's reasonable opinion, a similar specification to the Car.



6.3 If You do not have either a Driving Licence or an Automatic Driving Licence, You are physically unable to drive the Car, or if You are not resident in the United Kingdom or Isle of Man, Camelot may, at its discretion, offer You a cash alternative. The cash alternative will be equal to the amount Camelot would have paid for the Car plus, if it hasn't already been paid, the £30,000 cash element of the Car Prize. Camelot's decision is final and binding in any dispute relating to whether You are a resident of the United Kingdom or Isle of Man, or not.

6.4 Unless Rule 6.3 applies, there is no cash alternative (and You cannot request a cash alternative) to the Car or the Car Prize.

## 7. Law

The relevant law for these Rules is English law, and any legal proceedings will be heard in the English Courts.

## 8. Meaning of words

Capitalised words and terms in these Rules have the meanings set out below. Any capitalised words or terms not explained below will, except where the context implies otherwise, have the meaning given to them in the Scratchcard Rules.

**Automatic Driving Licence:** a full driving licence currently valid in the United Kingdom which authorises its holder to drive only motor vehicles with automatic transmission.

**Camelot:** Camelot UK Lotteries Limited, a company registered in England and Wales.

**Car:** a manual BMW X2 sDrive18i Sport SAC B38 1.5i model car which is part of the Car Prize.

**Car Manufacturer:** BMW Group United Kingdom Limited trading as BMW UK.

**Car Prize:** a prize won in the Game entitling You to a Car together with the sum of £30,000 payable by CHAPS. For the avoidance of doubt, motor insurance for the Car is not included in the Car Prize and is Your sole responsibility.

**Claimant:** a Player who makes a claim for a Car Prize within the period set out in Rule 1.1.

**Dealer:** Berry Chiswick (or such other dealer appointed from time to time) being a dealer in cars produced by the Car Manufacturer.

**Driving Licence:** a full driving licence currently valid in the United Kingdom that authorises its holder to drive manual and automatic motor vehicles, including the Car and similar vehicles.

**Nominee:** a person nominated by You (with Camelot's consent) to receive delivery of, or collect, the Car on Your behalf. The appointment of the Nominee, and the Nominee itself, must comply with the criteria set out in Rule 2.3.

**You:** a Claimant whose claim is validated by Camelot in accordance with these Rules and the Scratchcard Rules.
