

# Hidden Treasures Game Procedures

## Introduction

These are the Game Procedures for HIDDEN TREASURES (the "Game"). When the Game is played, the Rules for Scratchcard Games (the "Rules") and these Procedures apply. The Rules can be viewed at Retailers and on the National Lottery website at national-lottery.co.uk .

Any word or term in these Procedures that has a specific meaning will have the meaning given to it in these Procedures or the Rules (unless the context clearly indicates otherwise).

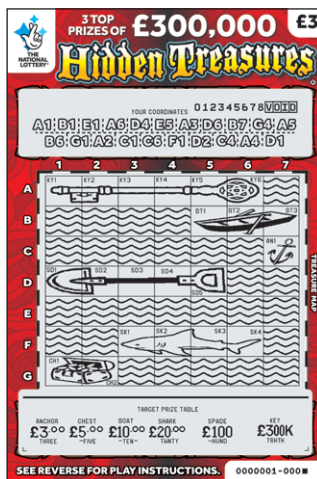

There is a 1 in 3.51 overall chance of winning a Prize on each Scratchcard in this Game. There are 9,054,600 Scratchcards in the initial print run of this Game.







## How to play and win

The Play Area is made up of one box labelled 'SCRATCH HERE FIRST - YOUR COORDINATES' (the "Your Coordinates Section"), a grid labelled 'TREASURE MAP' (the "Treasure Map") and a box labelled 'TARGET PRIZE TABLE' (the "Target Prize Table").



The Your Coordinates Section consists of 21  motifs. Under the coating

of each  motif is a coordinate which is made up of one letter and one number (a "Coordinate Play Symbol"), together the "Coordinate Play Symbols". The Treasure Map consists of 49 squares which each have a coordinate located on the Treasure Map. Under the coating of each square is a Treasure Play Symbol.

The Target Prize Table consists of the following motifs and associated text: 'ANCHOR' , 'CHEST' , 'BOAT' , 'SHARK' , 'SPADE'  or 'KEY'  (individually, an "Object" or together, the "Objects") and the word 'PRIZE' below each of the motifs with their associated text (the "Prize Box").

To play, scratch off all of the coating in the Your Coordinates Section to reveal 21 Coordinate Play Symbols. Then scratch off only those squares in the Treasure Map that correspond to the Coordinate Play Symbols revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section.

You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if, after scratching only those squares in the Treasure Map that correspond to the Coordinate Play Symbols revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section, You reveal Treasure Play Symbols which form a complete Object(s) in the Treasure Map. The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol, shown with its matching Prize Caption, under the coating of the Prize Box in the Target Prize Table immediately below the name of the Object revealed in the Target Prize Table.

Players can win up to 5 times on a Scratchcard.

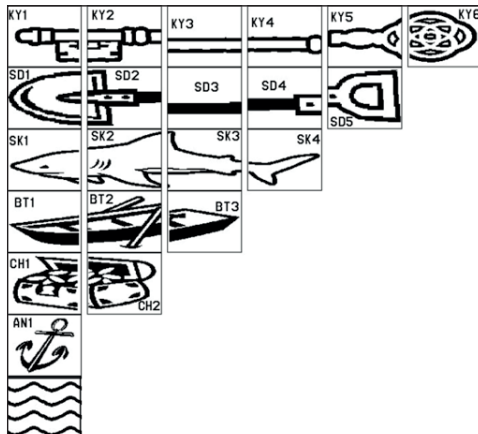

21 Coordinate Play Symbols will appear under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section. Only the Coordinate Play Symbols can be used to play the Game.

#### Treasure Play Symbols for the Treasure Map



One Treasure Play Symbol will appear in each of the 49 squares under the coating of the Treasure Map. Only those Treasure Play Symbols which you reveal by scratching off the coating on the Treasure Map squares which correspond with the Coordinate Play Symbols revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section, can be used to confirm the amount of a Prize You may be entitled to, if any, in the Target Prize Table.

Treasure Play Symbols from one Object cannot be combined with Treasure Play Symbols from any other Object(s) to win.

The KEY Object will consist of 6 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering KY1 to KY6, as shown in row 1 of the Treasure Play Symbols table above.

The SPADE Object will consist of 5 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering SD1 to SD5, as shown in row 2 of the Treasure Play Symbols table above.

The SHARK Object will consist of 4 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering SK1 to SK4, as shown in row 3 of the Treasure Play Symbols table above.

The BOAT Object will consist of 3 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering BT1 to BT3, as shown in row 4 of the Treasure Play Symbols table above.

The CHEST Object will consist of 2 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering CH1 and CH2, as shown in row 5 of the Treasure Play Symbols table above.

The ANCHOR Object will consist of 1 square denoted by the lettering AN1, as shown in row 6 of the Treasure Play Symbols table above.

All other squares in the Treasure Map will contain the  Treasure Play Symbol, as shown in row 7 of the Treasure Play Symbols table above.

#### Prize Value in The Game

The total value of Prizes in the print run of Scratchcards for the Game represents 67.01% of the total face value of Scratchcards. The overall value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game is £18,202,050.

The number of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game relates to the number of Scratchcards recorded on Camelot's Computer System and formally notified to the Gambling Commission before any Scratchcards are sold. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account any future sale or loss of Scratchcards, or future withdrawal of Scratchcards (where those Scratchcards are withdrawn by Camelot without knowledge of whether they are Prize bearing Scratchcards).

#### General

In the event of any conflict between these Procedures and any other information issued by Camelot in relation to this Game, these Procedures will take priority.
