

# Jewel Smash Game Procedures

## Introduction

These are the Game Procedures for JEWEL SMASH (the "Game"). When the Game is played, the Rules for Scratchcard Games (the "Rules") and these Procedures apply. The Rules can be viewed at Retailers and on the National Lottery website at [national-lottery.co.uk](http://national-lottery.co.uk).

Any word or term in these Procedures that has a specific meaning will have the meaning given to it in these Procedures or the Rules (unless the context clearly indicates otherwise).

## Game details



There is a 1 in 3.70 overall chance of winning a Prize on each Scratchcard in this Game. There are 8,678,940 Scratchcards in the initial print run of this Game.

## How to play and win

The Play Area has four sections, one headed 'SCRATCH HERE FIRST YOUR COORDINATES' (the "Your Coordinates Section") and three prize tables each of which are labelled 'PRIZE TABLE' (each a "Prize Table").

The Your Coordinates Section consists of eighteen  motifs. Under

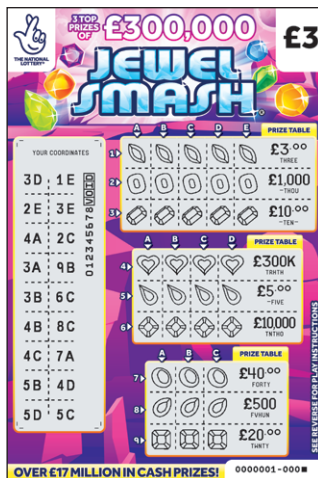
the coating of each  motif is a coordinate which is made up of one letter and one number (a "Coordinate Play Symbol", together the "Coordinate Play Symbols").

Each Prize Table contains letters at the top of each column, and numbers on the left hand side of each row. Each row in a Prize Table contains a number of squares with symbols printed on the coating. At the end of each row in a Prize Table is the word 'PRIZE' (the "Prize Box").

To play, first scratch off all of the coating in the Your Coordinates Section to reveal eighteen Coordinate Play Symbols. Then scratch off only those squares in a Prize Table(s) that correspond to the Coordinate Play Symbols revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section.

You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if, after scratching only those squares in a Prize Table(s) that correspond to the Coordinate Play Symbols revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section, You reveal all of the Play Symbols in a horizontal row in a Prize Table(s). The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol shown with its matching Prize Caption under the coating of the Prize Box for that row.

A Player can win up to 5 times on a ticket.

Only the Prize Symbol and its matching Prize Caption under the coating of a Prize Box in a row in a Prize Table can be used to confirm the amount of a Prize You may be entitled to, if any, in respect of the Game. Prize Symbols in one row in a Prize Table cannot be combined with Prize Symbols in any other row in that Prize Table, or any row in another Prize Table to win.

### Prize Value in The Game

The total value of Prizes in the print run of Scratchcards for the Game represents 66.99% of the total face value of Scratchcards. The overall value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game is £17,440,896.00.

The number of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game relates to the number of Scratchcards recorded on Camelot's Computer System and formally notified to the Gambling Commission before any Scratchcards are sold. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account any future sale or loss of Scratchcards, or future withdrawal of Scratchcards (where those Scratchcards are withdrawn by Camelot without knowledge of whether they are Prize bearing Scratchcards).

### General

In the event of any conflict between these Procedures and any other information issued by Camelot in relation to this Game, these Procedures will take priority (except if any Game Specific Rules apply to this Game in which case they will take priority over these Procedures).
