## Jungle Jackpot Game Procedures

## Introduction

These are the Game Procedures for JUNGLE JACKPOT (the "Game"). When the Game is played, the Rules for Scratchcard Games (the "Rules") and these Procedures apply. The Rules can be viewed at Retailers and on the National Lottery website at national-lottery.co.uk.
Any word or term in these Procedures that has a specific meaning will have the meaning given to it in these Procedures or the Rules (unless the context clearly indicates otherwise).

## Game details

Game Name: "JUNGLE JACKPOT"

Retail Sales Price: $£ 3$ per Scratchcard
There is a 1 in 3.63 overall chance of winning a Prize on each Scratchcard in this Game. There are 10,969,620 Scratchcards in the initial print run of this Game.

## How to play and win

The Play Area has four sections, one headed 'SCRATCH HERE FIRST YOUR COORDINATES' (the "Your Coordinates Section") and three prize tables, each of which are labelled 'PRIZE TABLE' (each a "Prize Table").

## The Your Coordinates Section consists of eighteen

 motifs (the
 colour of which will vary). Under the coating of each ? motif is a coordinate which is made up of one letter and one number (a "Your Coordinates Play Symbol", together the "Your Coordinates Play Symbols").
Each Prize Table contains letters at the top of each column, and numbers on the left hand side of each row. Each horizontal row in a Prize Table contains a number of squares with symbols on the coating. At the end of each horizontal row in a Prize Table is the word 'PRIZE' (the "Prize Box").
To play, first scratch off all of the coating in the Your Coordinates Section to reveal eighteen Your Coordinates Play Symbols. Then scratch off only those squares in the horizontal row(s) in the Prize Table(s) that correspond to the Your Coordinates Play Symbols revealed under the coating in the Your Coordinates Section.
You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if, after scratching only those squares in the horizontal row(s) in the Prize Table(s) that correspond to the Your Coordinates Play Symbols revealed under the coating in the Your Coordinates Section, You reveal all of the Play Symbols in a horizontal row in a Prize Table(s). The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol shown with its matching Prize Caption under the coating of the Prize Box for that completed row.
A Player can win up to 5 times on a ticket.

Eighteen Your Coordinates Play Symbols will appear under the coating in the Your Coordinates Section.
Play Symbols for the Prize Tables


Three, Four or Five Play Symbols (depending on the Prize Table) will appear under the coating of each row in the Prize Tables. Play Symbols in one row in a Prize Table cannot be combined with Play Symbols in any other row or with any other Play Symbols in any other Prize Table to win.

Only the Prize Symbol and its matching Prize Caption under the coating of a Prize Boxin a row in a Prize Table can be used to confirm the amount of a Prize You may be entitled to, if any, in respect of that row.

## Prize Value in The Game

The total value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game represents $65.85 \%$ of the total face value of Scratchcards. The overall value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game is $£ 21,671,029$.
The number of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game relates to the number of Scratchcards recorded on Allwyn's Computer System and formally notified to the Gambling Commission before any Scratchcards are sold. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account any future sale or loss of Scratchcards, future withdrawal of Scratchcards (where those Scratchcards are withdrawn by Allwyn without knowledge of whether they are Prize bearing Scratchcards), or additional print run(s) of Scratchcards for the Game. Providing a top prize remains available Allwyn may print further Scratchcards for this Game. If a further print run of Scratchcards for this Game is made, then, for the Scratchcards produced in that further print run, the overall odds of winning a Prize at each Prize tier level will be, all wing for the tolerance levels as specified in the table above, the same as in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game.

## General

In the event of any conflict between the Rules, these Procedures and any other information issued by Allwy in relation to this Game, the Rules will take priority followed by the Procedures and then any other information issued by Allwyn.
