

# Mega Cashword Pink Game Procedures

## Introduction

These are the Game Procedures for MEGA CASHWORD PINK (the "Game"). When the Game is played, the Rules for Scratchcard Games (the "Rules") and these Procedures apply. The Rules can be viewed at Retailers and on the National Lottery website at [national-lottery.co.uk](http://national-lottery.co.uk).

Any word or term in these Procedures that has a specific meaning will have the meaning given to it in these Procedures or the Rules (unless the context clearly indicates otherwise).

## Game details

Game Name: "MEGA CASHWORD PINK"

Game Number: "Game 1202"

Retail Sales Price: £5 per Scratchcard

There is a 1 in 3.70 overall chance of winning a Prize on each Scratchcard in this Game. There are 6,985,020 Scratchcards in the initial print run of this Game.

## How to play and win

There are four areas on the Scratchcard labelled as 'YOUR LETTERS' (the "Your Letters Section"), 'GRID 1', 'GRID 2' (the "Word Grids", each a "Word Grid") and 'PRIZE TABLE' (the "Prize Table").

To play the Game You must scratch off all of the coating in the Your Letters Section first to reveal eighteen Play Symbols. Then, scratch off the coating of the Play Symbols in the Word Grids which match the Play Symbols You have revealed under the coating in the Your Letters Section.

You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if, after scratching off the coating of the Play Symbols in the Word Grids that match the Play Symbols revealed under the coating in the Your Letters Section, You reveal three or more complete words under the coating of a Word Grid (the "Winning Words").

**Note:** A win is defined by matching 3 or more complete words on one Word Grid. Words within words (for example TO, TON, ONE in the word STONE) will not be considered 'complete' words.

The Prize will be the Prize shown in the Prize Table for the corresponding number of Winning Words revealed under the coating of each Word Grid.

Players can win up to 2 times on a Scratchcard.

## Play Symbols

Only the Play Symbols can be used to play the Game.

Play Symbols combined to form a Winning Word must appear in an unbroken horizontal (left to right) sequence or unbroken vertical (top to bottom) sequence of letters within a Word Grid.

### Prize Value in The Game

The total value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game represents 72.14% of the total face value of Scratchcards. The overall value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game is £25,196,275.

The number of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game relates to the number of Scratchcards recorded on Camelot's Computer System and formally notified to the Gambling Commission before any Scratchcards are sold. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account any future sale or loss of Scratchcards, future withdrawal of Scratchcards (where those Scratchcards are withdrawn by Camelot without knowledge of whether they are Prize bearing Scratchcards), or additional print run(s) of Scratchcards for the Game. Providing a top prize remains available, Camelot may print further Scratchcards for this Game. If a further print run of Scratchcards for this Game is made, then, for the Scratchcards produced in that further print run, the overall odds of winning a Prize at each Prize tier level will be, allowing for the tolerance levels as specified in the table above, the same as in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game.

### General

In the event of any conflict between these Procedures and any other information issued by Camelot in relation to this Game, these Procedures will take priority.
