

Money Kingdom Game Procedures

Introduction

These are the Game Procedures for MONEY KINGDOM (the "Game"). When the Game is played, the Rules for Scratchcard Games (the "Rules") and these Procedures apply. The Rules can be viewed at Retailers and on the National Lottery website at national-lottery.co.uk.

Any word or term in these Procedures that has a specific meaning will have the meaning given to it in these Procedures or the Rules (unless the context clearly indicates otherwise).

Game details

Game Name: "MONEY KINGDOM"

Game Number: "Game 1263"

Retail Sales Price: £5 per Scratchcard

There is a 1 in 3.42 overall chance of winning a Prize on each Scratchcard in this Game. There are 7,228,500 Scratchcards in the initial print run of this Game.


How to play and win

The Play Area is made up of a box labelled 'SCRATCH HERE FIRST – YOUR COORDINATES' (the "Your Coordinates Section"), a grid labelled 'MAIN GAME PLAYING GRID' (the "Playing Grid"), a panel labelled 'PRIZE TABLE' (the "Prize Table"), and a box labelled 'BONUS GAME' (the "Bonus Game").

Players can win up to 6 times on a Scratchcard.

MAIN GAME

The Your Coordinates Section consists of twenty-one  motifs. Under

the coating of each  motif is a coordinate which is made up of one letter and one number (a "Coordinate Play Symbol", together the "Coordinate Play Symbols").

The Playing Grid consists of 56 squares. Across the top of the Playing Grid are numbers, and along the left hand side of the Playing Grid are letters together forming a coordinate.

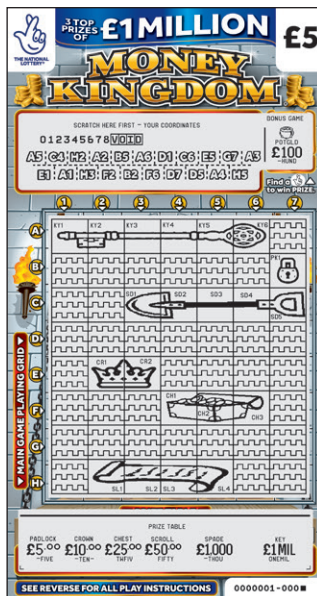
The Prize Table consists of the following motifs and associated text:



'PADLOCK', 'CROWN', 'CHEST', 'SCROLL', 'SPADE' and 'KEY' (individually, an "Object" together, the "Objects") and the word 'PRIZE' below each of the Objects (each "Prize Box").

To play, first scratch off all of the coating in the Your Coordinates Section to reveal 21 Coordinate Play Symbols. Then scratch off only those squares in the Playing Grid that correspond to the Coordinate Play Symbols You have revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section.

You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if, after scratching only those squares in the Playing Grid that correspond to the Coordinate Play Symbols revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section, You reveal a complete Object(s) under the coating in the Playing Grid. The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol shown with its matching Prize Caption under the coating of the Prize Box in the Prize Table immediately below that Object(s).

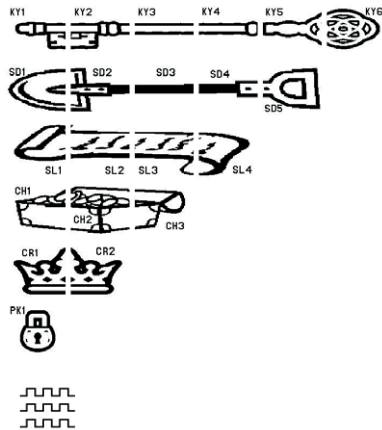

Twenty-one Coordinate Play Symbols will appear under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section. Only the Your Coordinate Play Symbols can be used to play the MAIN GAME.

Play Symbols for the Playing Grid



One Play Symbol will appear under the coating of each of the 56 squares in the Playing Grid. Only the Play Symbols which complete an Object(s) which you reveal by scratching off the coating of the Playing Grid squares which correspond to the Coordinate Play Symbols revealed under the coating of the Your Coordinates Section, can be used to confirm the amount of a Prize You may be entitled to, if any.

The KEY Object will consist of 6 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering KY1 to KY6 as shown above.

The SPADE Object will consist of 5 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering SD1 to SD5 as shown above.



The SCROLL Object will consist of 4 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering SL1 to SL4 as shown above.

The CHEST Object will consist of 3 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering CH1 to CH3 as shown above.

The CROWN Object will consist of 2 squares, each showing different images but denoted by the lettering CW1 and CW2 as shown above.

The PADLOCK Object will consist of 1 square denoted by the lettering PK1 as shown above.



All other squares in the Playing Grid will contain a 'Play Symbol' as shown above.

One Prize Symbol with its matching Prize Caption will appear under the coating of each Prize Box in the Prize Table. Only one Prize Caption appears under each Prize Symbol. Only the Prize Symbol and its matching Prize Caption under the coating of a Prize Box can be used to confirm the amount of a Prize You may be entitled to, if any, in respect of revealing a complete Object in the Playing Grid.

BONUS GAME

The BONUS GAME Play Area has one  motif and the word 'PRIZE' (the "Prize Box") directly below that motif. You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if You reveal a  Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption under the coating of the  motif. The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol shown with its matching Prize Caption under the coating of the Prize Box directly below the  Play Symbol.

One BONUS GAME Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption will appear under the coating in the BONUS GAME Play Area. Only the BONUS GAME Play Symbols and Play Captions can be used to play the BONUS GAME.

Prize Value in The Game

The total value of Prizes in the print run of Scratchcards for the Game represents 69.97% of the total face value of Scratchcards. The overall value of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game is £25,289,235.00.

The number of Prizes in the initial print run of Scratchcards for the Game relates to the number of Scratchcards recorded on Camelot's Computer System and formally notified to the Gambling Commission before any Scratchcards are sold. The details in these Procedures will not be revised to take into account any future sale or loss of Scratchcards, or future withdrawal of Scratchcards (where those Scratchcards are withdrawn by Camelot without knowledge of whether they are Prize bearing Scratchcards).

General

In the event of any conflict between these Procedures and any other information issued by Camelot in relation to this Game, these Procedures will take priority.
