## Introduction

You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win a Prize if You reveal a Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption under the coating in the Your Dogs Section that matches a Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption under the coating in the Winning Dog Section. The Prize will be equal to the amount of the Prize Symbol shown with its matching Prize Caption under the coating of the Prize Box immediately below that matching Play Symbol with its matching Play Caption in the Your Dogs Section.
Ifyou reveal a' Dogs Section, You will, providing the requirements of the Rules and these Procedures are met, win $£ 10$ automatically as a Prize.
